Important information:

1. Research Grants are available for either basic science or clinical research
2. Maximum award is \$20,000 for one year with the exception of multicenter studies (\$30,000)
3. FOT does not pay indirect institutional costs
4. Grant applications should be concise, well-organized, and readable
5. If awarded, study completion is expected within one year of funding
6. If selected, grants recipients agree to present their data at the FOT Annual Meeting

<p>III. Importance of the Research Question to Orthopaedic Traumatology: <i>Briefly present the impact you think your research might have on orthopaedic trauma clinical practice or for future research effects.</i></p>		
<p>IV. Research Design: <i>Give a brief review of your study design and research method (as one would in an abstract for a meeting presentation).</i></p>
